SLOW-THE-FLOW IRRIGATION AUDITS

Sign up and a trained irrigation auditor will help you save water! Audits identify sprinkler systems' efficiency, review watering schedules and more. Free repairs and sprinkler upgrades will be made, where applicable. Audits are scheduled for June through September.

RAIN SENSORS

Make sure you don't water when it's raining by installing a rain sensor. These sensors shut-off your irrigation system when they detect rain, helping you save water. When you pay for a discounted install, we'll give you the sensor for free. **COST: \$42**
