

FLOOD SAFETY

Boulder has the highest risk of flash floods in Colorado.

Floods don't always behave the same way and may not occur over an extended period of time as the 2013 flood did.

▷ MAINTAIN THE FLOODPLAIN

Storm drains lead to creeks! **Protect** our waterways by clearing debris and keeping pollutants out of storm drains.

▷ KEEP PEOPLE SAFE

Move to higher ground and do not drive or wade through floodwaters.

▷ INSURE YOUR HOME

Property owners should **insure** the safety of their home by purchasing flood insurance. Boulder customers currently receive up to 25% discounts on flood insurance and you can buy flood insurance whether or not your property is located in a floodplain.

▷ BUILD RESPONSIBLY

Before beginning any flood-related projects for your property, contact Planning & Development Services at 303-441-1880 to **assess** whether a City of Boulder permit is needed.

▷ PROTECT YOUR PROPERTY

Keep electrical components, furniture, valuables, and important documents in a **secure** place or above the projected flood elevation.
