

ATTACHMENT A: Council Chambers Existing Floor Plan




Existing Floor Plan 

- Replace outdated analog equipment with digital provisions
- Improve poor visibility of display screens for council and audience
- Solve lack of integrated controls for presentations and audio systems
- Improve marginal audio levels and intelligibility on dais for council and staff
- Provide recording and broadcast capabilities for meetings in flex space
- Improve image issues with Channel 8 presentation feed including difficulties for channel 8 controls

ATTACHMENT B: Council Chambers Upgrade, Proposed Concept Design Plan




Concept Floor Plan 

- Move main desk closer to public, resulting in additional office and meeting space
- Improve public and dais vision of presentation screens
- Improve access to dais
- Improve lighting
- Modernize finishes

Revised Floor Plan



- Council desk is 9 feet closer to audience
- Improved wheelchair access to the dais and better access to restrooms
- Larger CAO Office and Meeting Room
- Reduced project complexity
- More efficient kitchen
- Large format display screens on north and south walls for improved visibility from dais and audience
