BOHO also runs the Resident’ shelter, open to chronically homeless residents with a record of good behavior.

### Boulder Shelter for the Homeless (BSH)

Beginning Saturday, Oct. 1st 2016, emergency shelter residents will need to sign up ahead of time to be considered for a bed at the shelter. Options for sign-up include:

7:30pm-7:30am Daily: Sign up in person at the shelter with staff. For those staying overnight or using AM services only. No walk ups.

**OR**

8-10am Daily: Call in and leave a message or text your full name, gender and full date of birth to 720-432-2815.

After a lottery is conducted, a list of all residents to be admitted for the night will be posted on the Boulder Shelter website ([bouldershelter.org](http://bouldershelter.org)) by noon under 'Tonight's Intake'. Those who are admitted must arrive between 5PM and 7PM to claim their bed.

**Everyone must sign up in advance to have access to nightly emergency beds.**

Monday through Friday there is a FREE bus to Boulder Shelter for the Homeless which leaves Walnut & 11<sup>th</sup> (Boulder, CO 80302) at 5PM.
