UHCAMC At-Large Commissioner Seat Open Until Filled

The **University Hill General Improvement District** (UHGID) was established when Hill Commercial Area property owners petitioned to tax themselves to provide sufficient parking to serve district businesses. The scope of work funded by the GID was expanded in the 1980s to include district maintenance, marketing and access services. GIDs have a board appointed by the City Council to advise them on policy and budgeting matters. The **University Hill Commercial Area Management Commission** (UHCAMC) consists of five Boulder residents, three of which must represent Hill Commercial Area property owners (including business owners) and two of which must be 'at-large' residents of the city. The board meets once a month for 1-2 hours. There is currently an open 'at large' seat. To apply, fill out the application [HERE](#). The position is now open until filled.
