

## Project Background

19th Street provides access to several area schools including Crest View Elementary, Boulder Waldorf and Centennial Middle schools as well as bicycling and walking facilities for area residents and visitors. There have been several requests from area residents and the school communities for improved walking and bicycling facilities. There are some sidewalks and bicycle facilities along 19th Street but they are incomplete and in some places are a substandard design.

In 2014, the City of Boulder applied for and received federal Transportation Alternatives Program funding to improve the sidewalk from Norwood to Sumac avenues.

5' detached sidewalk along the east side of 19th Street (Norwood to Sumac) and completion of missing sidewalk sections on the west side of 19th Street


## Project Cost Estimate for Initial Project Scope
