In 2014, significant construction and maintenance activities will enhance downtown Boulder for the entire community's benefit. The improvements will make downtown Boulder a more beautiful, safe, and vibrant place for businesses, residents, and visitors.

Projects marked with a  are funded, in part or in full, by the 2011 voter-approved Capital Improvement Bond. There will also be construction and traffic impacts associated with the private developments in downtown Boulder.

ANNUAL SIDEWALK REPAIR PROGRAM SPRING THROUGH SUMMER 2014

- Repairs to damaged sidewalks and pedestrian ramp upgrades to meet ADA standards.
- There will be periodic sidewalk closures throughout the downtown area.
- The City of Boulder shares the cost of sidewalk repairs with property owners.

PEARL STREET MALL IRRIGATION REPLACEMENT WINTER/SPRING 2014 AND FALL 2014

- Through April 2014, there will be temporary area closures and detours on the 1200 block of the Pearl Street Mall, including the east side of Broadway and west side of 13th Street.
- Access to the 1200 block and businesses will be maintained throughout the project.
- Work in the 1400 block of Pearl Street is expected to begin in fall 2014 or the beginning of 2015.

WEST PEARL STREETScape IMPROVEMENTS FEBRUARY 2014 THROUGH FALL 2014

- Installation of pedestrian, irrigation, and streetscape improvements on Pearl Street between 7th and 11th streets, including the 9th and 10th street intersections.
- There will be sidewalk closures and parking restrictions for one to two months along each one-block section as work proceeds from east to west.
- Access to adjacent businesses will be maintained at all times and a sidewalk on one side of the street will always remain open.

ARAPAHOE AVENUE RECONSTRUCTION (FOLSOM TO 15TH STREETS) CONTINUING THROUGH FALL 2014

- Reconstruction of Arapahoe Avenue into concrete from Folsom Street to approximately 15th Street.
- Arapahoe Avenue will be narrowed to one eastbound lane during summer construction.
- During winter and spring, there will be two-way traffic with lane closures during off-peak hours.

BOULDER TRANSIT CENTER AREA IMPROVEMENTS (PHASE TWO) SUMMER 2014

- Improving transportation options for the Boulder Transit Center area.
- Pedestrian detours will be in place.

MAIN LIBRARY RENOVATIONS - FEBRUARY 2014 TO SEPTEMBER 2014

- Renovation of the Main Boulder Public Library, including the children's area, teen area, and the adult fiction, music, and movie collections.
- Replacement of outdated electrical and data distribution systems, repair/replacement of clerestory windows, ADA accessibility improvements, replacement of worn carpeting, and provision of facilities for café service.

ROAD PAVEMENT REPAIR AND ROAD RECONSTRUCTION SUMMER 2014

- Repair road pavement on deteriorating roads at various locations west of 15th Street.
- This involves crack-filling, overlay, reconstruction and concrete repair.
