To Receive a Rebate You Must Provide the Following Documentation

If you received a rebate in 2013, you may not need to resubmit all documentation in 2014.
Please see attached form entitled, "If You Received A Rebate in 2013" for more information.

- Proof of Residency** - Applicants must have lived in the City of Boulder continuously from January 1, 2013 through December 31, 2013. Proof of residency may include one or more of the following documents: lease, deed, property tax receipt, completed "Landlord Affidavit" signed by your landlord or housing provider, or other proof establishing full-year residency.
- Proof of Income** - Applicants must provide a copy of their federal income tax return for 2013. If you were not required to file a federal income tax return for 2013, you must complete the attached "Oath of Income" and submit documentation of income for 2013. See chart below for household income limits.
- Proof of Category** – All dependents listed on the first page must be claimed as exemptions on your 2013 federal income tax return. If you were not required to file a federal income tax return for 2013, you must provide copies of birth certificates. Children of separated or divorced couples must have lived in the City of Boulder for all of 2013. Disabled persons must provide proof of receiving disability benefits. If you don't receive disability benefits, you can submit a letter documenting your disability status from an agency serving people with disabilities or a certified health care provider. If you are applying as a senior you must have been at least 62 years of age for all of 2013.
- Affidavit of Legal Residency** – All applicants must include a signed Affidavit of Legal Residency.

If You Received a Rebate in 2013
Please Read This Form Carefully and Provide the Appropriate Documentation

Proof of Income – All applicants must provide a copy of their federal income tax return for 2013. If you were not required to file a federal income tax return for 2013, you must complete the attached “Income Oath” and submit documentation of income for 2013.

Affidavit of Legal Residency – If you received a rebate in 2013, you **do not** need to resubmit the Affidavit of Legal Residency.

Proof of Category –

Family:

If applying as a family with children, all dependents listed on the Food Tax Rebate Application form must be claimed as exemptions on your federal income tax return. If you were not required to file a federal income tax return for 2013, you must provide copies of birth certificates. Children of separated or divorced couples must have lived in the City of Boulder for all of 2013.

Disabled:

If you are disabled and received a rebate in 2013, you **do not** need to submit further proof of disability.

Senior:

If applying as a senior, you must have been at least 62 years of age for all of 2013.

Proof of Residency - If you still reside at the same address where you lived in 2012, and have lived there for the entire year of 2013, please sign the following oath and do not submit further proof of residence. If you have moved, you must submit proof of residence for all of 2013.
