

NEWS TO THE COMMUNITY

The 2016 City of Boulder Request for Proposals (RFP) for affordable housing and community development funding is now available.

In 2016 the City of Boulder will have approximately \$3.5 million available to provide to partners pursuing affordable housing and community development activities. Funds include:

- Affordable Housing Funds and Community Housing Assistance Program (CHAP) – Approximately \$3,000,000 in local funds are available to create and maintain the supply of permanently affordable housing for low- and moderate-income households.
- Community Development Block Grant Funds - Approximately \$500,000 in federal CDBG funds are available to meet the community development needs of low- and moderate-income persons. Provided by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) CDBG financial awards are contingent upon the City of Boulder's receipt of funds from HUD as well as compliance with Environmental Review, Section 3 and the Uniform Relocation Act required per 24 CFR Pt 570 and Appendix 1, Paragraph K.

A pre-application meeting will be held 11:30 am, May 27, 2015 at 1300 Canyon Blvd, Boulder, CO to give an opportunity to discuss funding requirements and the grant application process.

 - Pre-applications are required to be considered for funding.
- Affordable Housing Applications are due July 10, 2015 at 3:00 p.m.
- Community Development Applications are due July 24, 2015 at 3:00 p.m.

No late documents will be accepted.
