

29th Annual EXPAND Duck Race

Official Rules

Presented by the PLAY Boulder Foundation (the presenter), the City of Boulder Parks and Recreation Department's EXPAND Program and in cooperation with the Boulder Creek Festival.

1. Ducks will be launched from the Ninth Street Bridge at approximately 4:00 p.m. on Monday, May 30, 2016. The race course will run along Boulder Creek from the Ninth Street Bridge to Peace Park (immediately East of the Boulder Public Library) in Boulder, Colorado.
2. All ducks entered will be provided by the Presenter and shall remain the property of the Presenter.
3. Modification of the ducks is not allowed, nor can there be any interference with the ducks once the ducks have been launched, except at the discretion of the Race Committee. Only designated race course officials may guide the ducks during the race.
4. Each duck entered will be assigned a specific and unique duck entry number by the Presenter. This number will be affixed to its respective duck during the race.
5. All entries must be completely filled out and delivered to the Presenter or an authorized representative of the Presenter.
6. A \$5.00 donation per each duck entered is requested to benefit the Boulder Parks and Recreation EXPAND Program. Free race entries defeat the charitable fundraising purpose of this event and are not encouraged. However, one free duck entry per person can be obtained by completing the race entry form and returning it as described in number five above.
7. The winners shall be selected by the Presenters finish line judges, and their decisions are final. The winner shall be selected by the order in which the first ducks cross the finish line. The person's name(s) that appears on the entry form corresponding to the first ducks in order of finish will be selected for prizes.
8. Winners will be announced on our website: www.EXPANDduckrace.org. Entrants need not be present to win. Winners will be notified within fourteen working days after the race. If any prizes are left unclaimed after thirty days following the race, the prizes will be forfeited by those race winners.
9. Any and all taxes and fees are the sole responsibility of the winners. No cash equivalent prizes will be provided in lieu of the designated prizes. A list of prizes shall be available to entrants on the day of the race. Restrictions and limitations may apply to the prizes awarded.
10. Members of Duck Race committee, Board Members of PLAY Boulder Foundation, Boulder Parks and Recreation EXPAND Standard Staff, race officials and judges and their immediate families are not eligible to win prizes. Immediate family is defined as spouses/partners in civil unions and children.

11. By entering, winners consent to the promotional use of their names and likeness without additional compensation.
12. All decisions and interpretations of rules and regulations will be made by the Presenter and judgement is final.
13. By entering, entrants release the Presenter and its members, agent's employees, and other related entities from any and all liability with respect to prizes.
14. Anyone may enter. You must be 18 years of age or older to win. In the event that a minor wins a prize, that prize will be awarded to the minor's parent or legal guardian. Identification will be required to claim prizes.
