

Community and Environmental Assessment Process (CEAP)

What is the CEAP?

- A formal review process to consider the assessment of potential impacts of capital improvement projects for the selection of a recommended alternative
- An opportunity to balance multiple community goals in the design of a capital project by assessing a project against the policies outlined in the Boulder Valley Comprehensive Plan (BVCP), the Transportation Master Plan (TMP), and the North Boulder Sub-Community Plan

19th Street Multimodal Improvements Project CEAP

The 19th Street project was selected to use the CEAP by an interdepartmental team, known as the CEAP Committee, during the Capital Improvements Program (CIP) budget process. The CIP identifies major capital improvements the city will undertake over the next 5 years. The CEAP projects are reviewed by the Planning Board and adopted by City Council with the CIP budget.

The graphic below illustrates the steps of the CEAP Process:
