Instructions

Choose a time-keeper (role to keep the group on time and help ensure everyone gets a chance to speak)

1. Choose 2 people to record discussion points – one for each question.
2. Discuss question #1 – recorder captures discussion. Spend about 10 minutes.
3. Discuss question #2 – recorder captures discussion. Focus the group's time on this.
4. Final wrap-up – write the top topics your group discussed on the summary sheet.

Ground Rules

- **Be respectful.**
- **Be brief.**
- **Listen to each other.**
- **Let everyone share their ideas.**
- **You don't have to agree or come to consensus.** You can highlight where there is agreement but all views are important.
- **Be open to new perspectives.**

This information will directly inform the next part of the plan update by helping identify focus topics and range of policy and land use choices and issues to be considered. Sharing your ideas now will help us have more robust planning options for the community to review and consider later in the process.
