COMMUNITY ASSESSMENT - PARK SETTINGS

- OUTER PARK EDGES
- ACTIVE RECREATION AREAS
 - Major athletic fields and hard surface courts for organized activities
- PASSIVE RECREATION AREAS
 - Informal areas for individuals or groups to engage in free play and community events
- PLAYGROUNDS
 - Tot lots and elementary school area playgrounds
 - Supervision areas, parent seating, shade trees and gathering areas
- NATURAL LANDSCAPE
 - Remnant landscapes that may provide opportunity for nature play and wildlife observation
- STRUCTURES
 - Major buildings, restrooms, and other structures used for maintenance and storage that support park and recreation activities
- URBAN FOREST
 - Includes formal landscapes that have been planted as part of the overall park design
- PATHWAYS
 - Connections including paved bike trails, sidewalks, nature trails, and soft surface pathways in the park
