Admin Update

City Council Presentation

- The group conducted a review of the draft slides prepared by city staff and recommended revisions.
- Possible questions to address from Council:
 - Speaker should be prepared to share what type of model the highlighted cities have and explain why they were researched.
 - Council may ask how general recommendations tie to the different models.
 - How much will this cost? How long will it take? -This is dependent on the final recommendations.
 - Can you summarize for us what you need to move forward?
 - Do you anticipate current task force members would seek to be on a future oversight board?
 - How have members of the Police Department been involved in the process?
