Why Arapahoe Ridge Playground?

- Outdated playground equipment. Current equipment installed in 1989. Typical play equipment life span is about 15-20 years.
- Playground needs to be renovated to address current safety and compliance standards.
- Rock structure has identified structural and safety issues that must be addressed
- Outstanding maintenance issues: shelter and tennis courts
- Outdated site amenities: trash receptacles, benches, and picnic tables
- Address accessibility issues, Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA)





PROJECT SCOPE


- ❶ Tot Area with swings, sand play pit, clubhouse, rubber surface for climbing and balance.
- ❷ Play equipment and natural materials with engineered wood fiber surface for spinning, climbing and balance.
- ❸ Repair existing rock play feature and add slide.
- ❹ Repair existing shelter and stairs as required.
- ❺ Adjust path alignment to shelter.
- ❻ Sand Play

Arapahoe Ridge Playground Rehabilitation



PROJECT SCOPE

- 1 "Baby Crag" with slide from shelter, stone ledges, balance logs, and rubber surface.
- 2 "Big Crag" with climbing wall, slide, rope bridge, stacked boulders and logs, and wood fiber surface.
- 3 Restore existing rock play feature.
- 4 Repair existing shelter and stairs as required.
- 5 Improve existing planting areas.

Arapahoe Ridge Playground Rehabilitation



PROJECT SCOPE

- 1 Sand play area with natural materials.
- 2 "Forest" with wood fiber surface, slide and climbing net.
- 3 The "Divide" with rubber surfaced berm and swing, boulders, and timbers.
- 4 Evaluate, repair existing rock play feature.
- 5 Repair existing shelter and stairs as required.
- 6 Convert planted area to enlarge playground.
