

Boulder Outreach for Homeless Overflow (BOHO)



- Nights when the temperature is 38 degrees F or less with moisture or 32 degrees F or less with no moisture, emergency warming centers open
- **Call 303.605.8919 for recorded message to find out if a warming center is opening today (for status, location and time)**

BoHo will coordinate with other service providers to open additional day center sites during severe weather conditions when:

- Services are closed on holidays that fall on weekdays (Oct – April)
- Services are closed on major holidays (e.g., Christmas and New Years) that fall on weekend days
- Services open when daytime temperatures are less than 30 degrees and/or there are blizzard-like conditions
