The following items are PROHIBITED and should not be used in the residence halls. They are considered fire hazards and will be confiscated. Students possessing these items will be subject to academic sanctions, including community service.

Candles
Incense
Halogen Lamps
Bean Bag Chairs
Wall Tapestries
Hot Plates, Toasters/Ovens, Space Heaters, Indoor/Outdoor
Cooking Grills
Fireworks

**Boulder Fire-Rescue asks you to discuss these fire safety reminders
with your student:**

-  Always evacuate immediately when a fire alarm sounds!
-  Know 2 ways out!
-  Locate your exits - no matter where you are!
-  Attend all Fire Safety Floor Meetings.
-  Participate in scheduled fire drills.
-  Crawl low under smoke.
-  Ensure that smoke alarms have working batteries by testing the alarm at the beginning of each semester.
-  Fire sprinklers are important safety devices. Do not tamper with them or obstruct them in any way.
