WHAT'S THE PLAN?

Late November 2016 - March 2017

- Access to the buildings will be maintained at all times.
- Portions of the park will be closed during construction for your safety.
- During the earliest portion of construction, 39 parking spaces will be blocked off in the eastern portion of the Canyon/Municipal lot.
- Alternate parking is available at:
 - 1045 Arapahoe Library
Metered parking Monday - Saturday 9 a.m. to 7 p.m.; FREE 3 hr. parking for library patrons
 - Broadway and Arapahoe Park Central
Metered parking Monday - Friday 9 a.m. to 7 p.m.; Saturdays, Sundays and holidays are FREE
 - Parking garage at 11th and Walnut (Randolph Center)
 - Parking garage at 10th and Walnut (St. Julien)
 - Parking garage at 14th and Walnut (RTD)

- Visitors are encouraged to arrive by bus, bike or foot (this also aids Boulder's sustainability efforts).
