


# Cold Springs Fire Update

# Status of Response

- Since Saturday
  - Type III team established and led by Mike Smith (BFD), additional members from BFD assisted with response and team assignments.
  - Transition to Type II team (Team Black)
  - Aggressive air and ground attack-7 helicopters and 9 fixed wing aircraft
  - 606 acres involved-25% contained
  - 5 homes and 2 outbuildings destroyed to date
  - Over 450 Firefighters on scene
  - Full EOC activation
  - Multiple County/City divisions and external resources collaborated effectively





# Critical Infrastructure

- Water
  - Betasso Water Treatment Facility-secure
  - Lakewood reservoir-secure
  - Lakewood pipeline-secure
- Utilities-secure
- Communications-secure
- Road closures-Highway 119 closed from Sugarloaf road to Nederland-Fire Operations continuing in this area. Peak to Peak HWY open, HWY 72 open, RTD running delayed schedule due to rerouting.

# Significant events/progress

- Fire is expected to hold within the perimeter
- Barker reservoir is off the threat assessment
- Transition back to type III team in the next 3-5 days
- EOC transitioning to recovery mode in the next 48 hrs
- Total number in the shelters (East Boulder rec center/Nederland High school) 6 and 19 respectively
- Magnolia road has been opened

## Significant events/progress

- Sugarloaf removed from evacuation planning
- Red Cross closed the shelter at the east Boulder Community Center

# Status of Response

- Next 48 hours
  - Redeployment/demobilization of resources
  - Continuing damage assessment
  - Focus on maintaining infrastructure and assisting with recovery
