REGULATION TO EXPAND THE COLUMBINE
NEIGHBORHOOD PERMIT PARKING (NPP) ZONE

Having found that the proposed expansion of the zone has met all of the requirements set forth in Section 2-2-15, B.R.C., 1981, and the requirements for the Neighborhood Permit Parking Program Regulations, I declare that the Columbine Neighborhood Permit Parking Zone is expanded to include the following block faces: 2200 block of Mariposa (north and south).

The new boundaries of the zone are now: the 500 and 600 blocks (east and west) of 13th, 14th, 15th, 16th, 17th, 18th, 19th, 20th, 21st, and 22nd Streets; the 400 block of 22nd Street (east and west); the 400 and 500 blocks (west) of Sunny Side Lane; the 1300 block of Columbine Avenue (north and south); the 1400, 1500, 1600, 1700, 1800, 1900, 2000, 2100, and 2200 blocks (north and south) of Columbine; and the 2200 block (north and south) of Bluebell Avenue; and the 2200 block (north and south) of Mariposa.

All of the streets within the zone will be posted with signs that read: 2 Hour Parking, One Time Only Per Day, 9:00 AM to 5:00 PM, Monday through Friday, In This Purple Zone, Except by Permit.

Up to two commuter permits per block face will be available for purchase by non-zone residents on a quarterly basis.
