

30th & Colorado Underpass Project Comment Summary, February 7, 2018 Community Meeting

Comments received for the 30th & Colorado Underpass project at the February 7, 2018 30th & Colorado Corridor Study open house.

Approximately 50 people engaged with the 30th & Colorado Underpass station at the February 7, 2018 open house. Of those who did, 19 completed comment forms.

The comment form asked:

- What are your ideas for an underpass at 30th & Colorado?
- What information presented was most helpful?
- Please provide any additional information that you would like to share with the project team.

Of the comments received:

- 6 favored the “L” underpass
- 3 favored the Diagonal underpass
- 3 opposed the project
- 2 general supported the project
- 1 suggested an East-West crossing under 30th
- 1 suggested creating a vehicle underpass, and dedicating the on-street crossing to bikes & pedestrians

Three comments received requested a connection from the project area be made to College Avenue west of 30th to support travel to the underpass of 28th Street further west.

Two comments received stated improvements to the west side of 30th Street would increase travel on that side of the street and provide better connections to the Boulder Creek Multi-Use path and the 29th Street Mall.

One comment shared concern for the potential for conflict for eastbound travelers exiting the underpass and their interaction with other travelers.

One comment stated that at-grade improvements to the intersection were important because some users won't use the underpass, for example women and/or those traveling at night.

One comment stated that the at-grade improvements to the intersection may reduce the number of users who would benefit from the Diagonal underpass concept.

One comment stated concern for safety and accessibility of travelers during construction.
