


City of Boulder COMMERCIAL EnergySmart 2013 Program-to-Date Progress Report

PARTICIPATION IN ENERGYSMART BY BUSINESSES OR PROPERTY OWNERS





HIGHLIGHTS (Countywide)

- EnergySmart exceeded its BetterBuildings goal of 3000 businesses participating, 900 of which made upgrades.
- Assessments much more frequently (60%) continue to further Advising when Advisors conduct both.
- Market Transformation: 9 more contractors have completed at least 1 commercial energy efficiency upgrade, bringing the total to 177 contractors, and the availability of high efficiency HVAC equipment has improved.
- Conversion rates have increased due to the intensive advising our business partners are receiving
- Campaigns targeting flood impact, refrigeration, new businesses, and T12 elimination increased new interactions with potential energy efficiency projects.
- Almost 350, (nearly 40%) of our businesses are already halfway through their average project payback period of 4
