




City of Boulder RESIDENTIAL EnergySmart 2014 Program-to-Date Progress Report

This page summarizes progress to date since October 2010 in achieving the goals of the EnergySmart services toward the Department of Energy Better Building Grant awarded to Boulder County. The Better Building Residential EnergySmart goal was to have 10,000 homes participate in the program by May 2013. EnergySmart was conceived and developed through a joint effort of Boulder County Commissioners' Office of Sustainability, Boulder County Public Health, City of Boulder and City of Longmont. 

HIGHLIGHTS

- 48% of participants in EnergySmart across Boulder County cited energy cost savings as their primary reason to participate. 43% cited Smart Regs as their primary reason to participate.
- Air sealing and attic/ceiling insulation remain the top two upgrades overall
- Each dollar spent on residential energy efficiency rebates from the EnergySmart partners leverages about \$6.90 in private investment.
- County-wide 11,830 total residences are enrolled.
- During Q2 2014 EnergySmart assisted 3 Boulder homeowners with solar energy projects bringing the total to 14 solar projects in Boulder over the past year.
- During Q2 2014 EnergySmart was able to connect 56 homeowners with Slow the Flow, which is an outdoor water assessment initiative provided by the Center for Resource Conservation. 14 of these 56 homeowners reside within the City of Boulder.
