

Email Subject Line: RMB city ordinance changes to go to city council on Tuesday May 6, 2014 and RMB Conversion/Co-Location Processing Update

Email Text: Dear Medical Marijuana Business (MMB) or Recreational Marijuana Business (RMB) Boulder location owner:

The purpose of this email is to give you an update on the City of Boulder's RMB 100% conversions and RMB co-locations processing thus far. City licensing also wants to let you know that the city staff team is returning to city council in the next few weeks.

*Concerning RMB processing, out of 70 issued MMB licenses, city licensing has received 34 RMB conversion and co-location applications. From these 34 RMB applications, 25 RMB licenses have now been city approved, with only 9 RMB applications still pending. **Because our RMB processing has gone well, we will again start processing both MMB and RMB modifications on April 15 (we will post this on our website too).**

*Concerning city council upcoming process, the city staff team for marijuana licensing and enforcement is returning to city council for changes to our local Boulder Revised Code ahead of the city accepting new MMB and RMB license applications on June 1, 2014. A couple of important points are:

- The first reading for publication of the ordinance will be tomorrow so written comment can now be submitted. If you have written comment about council materials, you may submit those in writing to the City of Boulder city manager's office in a letter or via email to: council@bouldercolorado.gov
- The full city council meeting, with an opportunity to submit public comment, for second reading will be on **Tuesday May 6, 2014 at 6PM with the City Council**. - Please note that as described in the city council memo, one change the city staff group is recommending is that City of Boulder RMB conversion and co-locations application acceptance be ended on May 30, 2014. As such, if you have been holding off filing your RMB conversion or co-location application with city licensing, you will want to file now. For questions on RMB co-location timing as to if you must file with the State MED first, please just give us a call.
