

Boulder Civic Area Project | Thank you for visiting us today!




As you are someone who frequents the facilities/amenities in the Civic Area, we want to make sure you are aware of upcoming changes and how to access this building and its services.

WHAT'S THE PLAN?

Late November 2016 to March 2017

- Access to the buildings will be maintained at all times.
- Portions of the park will be closed during construction for your safety.
- During the earliest portion of construction, 39 parking spaces will be blocked off in the eastern portion of the Canyon/Municipal lot.
- Alternate parking is available at:
 - Main Boulder Public Library
Metered parking Monday to Friday 9 a.m. to 7 p.m.; FREE 90 min. parking for library patrons
 - Broadway and Arapahoe Park Central
Metered parking Monday to Friday 9 a.m. to 7 p.m.; Saturdays, Sundays and holidays are FREE
 - Parking garage at 11th and Walnut (Randolph Center)
 - Parking garage at 10th and Walnut (St. Julien)
 - Parking garage at 14th and Walnut (RTD)
 - More options at bouldercolorado.gov/parking-services
- Visitors are encouraged to arrive by bus, bike or foot (this also supports Boulder's sustainability efforts).
