

**REGULATION CREATING THE FAIRVIEW NEIGHBORHOOD ~~PERMIT PARKING~~
(NPP) ZONE**

Having found that the proposed zone has met all of the requirements set forth in Section 2-2-15, of the B.R.C., 1981, and the requirements of the adopted Neighborhood Permit Parking Program Regulations, I establish the Fairview Neighborhood Permit Parking (NPP) zone, consisting of the following block faces:

The 3600, 3700, 3800, and 3900 blocks of Longwood Avenue (north and south sides); the 1700 block of Gillaspie Drive (north and south sides) and the 3900 block of Greenbriar Boulevard (west side only).

The zone will be designated with a "color-coded" restriction on public parking as defined in the Neighborhood Permit Parking Program Regulations. Signs will be posted throughout the zone that read: 2 Hour Parking, one time only per day, 8:00 AM to 4:00 PM, Monday through Friday, School Days Only in This (Grey) Zone, Except by Permit.

The city manager may issue up to four commuter permits per block face based on a 25 percent white space level.

NOTICE OF A REGULATION CREATING THE FAIRVIEW NEIGHBORHOOD
PERMIT PARKING (NPP) ZONE**

The City Manager is issuing a regulation to create the Fairview Neighborhood Permit Parking (NPP) zone effective September 30, 2002. The zone will include the following block faces:

The 3600, 3700, 3800, and 3900 blocks of Longwood Avenue (north and south sides); the 1700 block of Gillaspie Drive (north and south sides) and the 3900 block of Greenbriar Boulevard (west side only).

The zone will be designated with a "color-coded" restriction on public parking as defined in the Neighborhood Permit Parking Program Regulations. Signs will be posted throughout the zone that read: 2 Hour Parking, one time only per day, 8:00 AM to 4:00 PM, Monday through Friday, School Days Only in This (Grey) Zone, Except by Permit.

The city manager may issue up to four commuter permits per block face based on a 25 percent white space level.
