League Descriptions

D Comp: Highest level of competition offered in Boulder leagues. League is made up of players with strong defensive skills, who hit consistently. 4 HR/game

D Rec: This competitive league is made up of players with strong defensive skills, who hit consistently. This is traditionally a competitive league.

Men: 2 HR/game, Coed: 3HR/game

E Comp: Players' skills level vary greatly- maybe your short stop was a high school all star and your catcher has never even caught a ball. Players in this league have the most diverse skill sets.

1 HR/game (S), 2HR/game (EM)

E Rec: Your team has very little experience playing softball and is just out there to have a good time.

0 HR/game (S), 2HR/game (EM)

Competitive Parity: *The City of Boulder has the right to place teams into leagues or divisions so competitive parity can be achieved*



Softball FAQ's

1. Where can I find my team schedule, standings, makeup's and a blank roster?

A— All league information is found on the softball webpage at www.bprsports.org. Game schedules for teams are located at www.teamsideline.com/boulder

2. The weather is looking bad, how do I find out if my game is cancelled?

A— Call the cancelation information line at 303-441-3410, we update the line as soon as a final decision has been made. We also update Twitter at #BPRsports.

3. How is the championship determined?

A— Standings are used to determine which place your team will be in and the time you will play. The 1st and 2nd place teams will play for the league championship. Winner take all!

4. I don't have enough players for my game, what should I do?

A— Call or email Megann at the sports office to forfeit your game. This must be done by 4pm or your team will need to pay a \$25.00 fine. Any team with 3 forfeits in a season will be dropped from the league.

5. Why do I need to attend the Manager's meeting?

A-It is important to attend these meetings to hear the new rules, understand reschedules, standings, championship week format, etc.

6. Why aren't my makeup games scheduled for the night I normally play?

A— Depending on the popularity of the night you play, we may not have any available fields to play on because of normally scheduled games. In Boulder, we play softball continuously March - October so we don't have the convenience of adding extra weeks on the season for makeup games.

7. What is the new limited gender restriction (LGR) league?

A— The LGR league allows teams to play with as few as two of a given gender on the field and in the batting order at any time. There are no other restrictions for fielding position placement or batting order. It is important teams still pay attention to the level of play. This season there is D and E rec.

(Examples: 8 men and 2 women; 4 men and 6 women; 3 men and 7 women; 5 men and 5 women.)
