Project Information

Location: 6300 Valmont Rd.

Type of Permit: Special Permit for Lethal Control of Prairie Dogs.

Description of Work:

Thirty prairie dogs will be trapped from the Valmont Butte property, immediately euthanized, and taken to labs to be test for uranium poisoning. Ten animals will be captured from the uranium tailings pond cap; ten will be captured from the ~~area~~ ^{area} just outside the cap; and ten will be trapped on-site but away from the cap area.

Conditions of Approval

- The proposed project/activity is approved on the basis that it satisfies applicable requirements of Chapter 6-1-39, "Special Permit," Boulder Revised Code 1981.
- The activity is limited to the capture of thirty prairie dogs. If additional animals are needed, an amendment to this permit must first be issued. The remaining prairie dogs on the site will not be removed from the site at this time.
