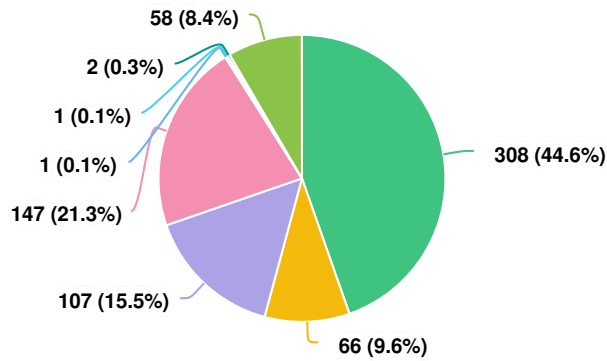

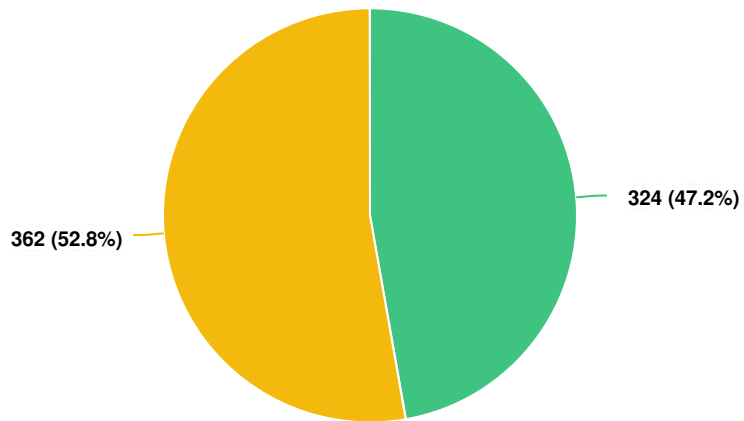

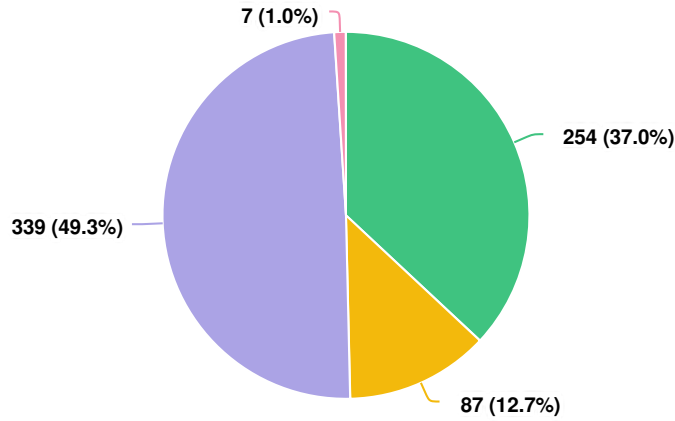

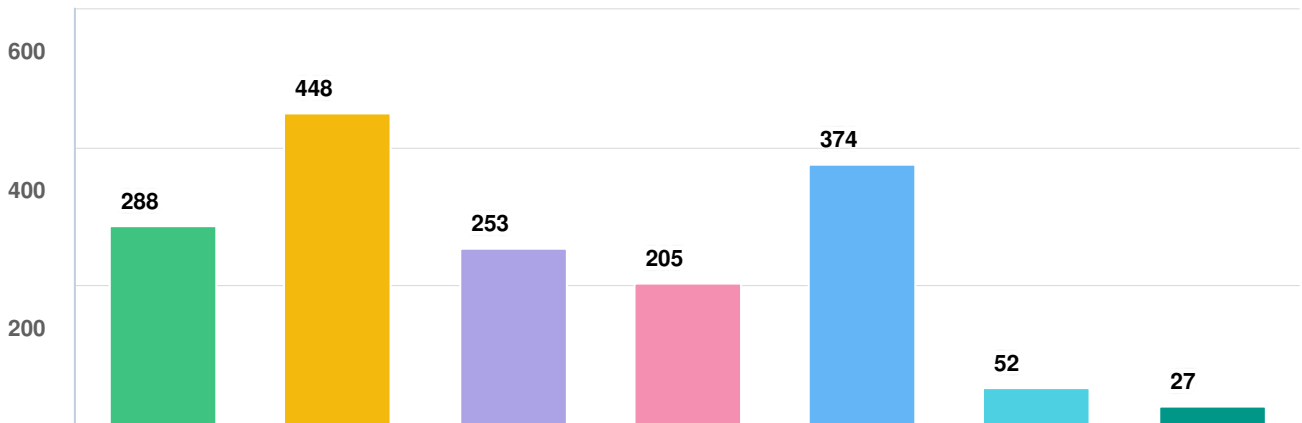

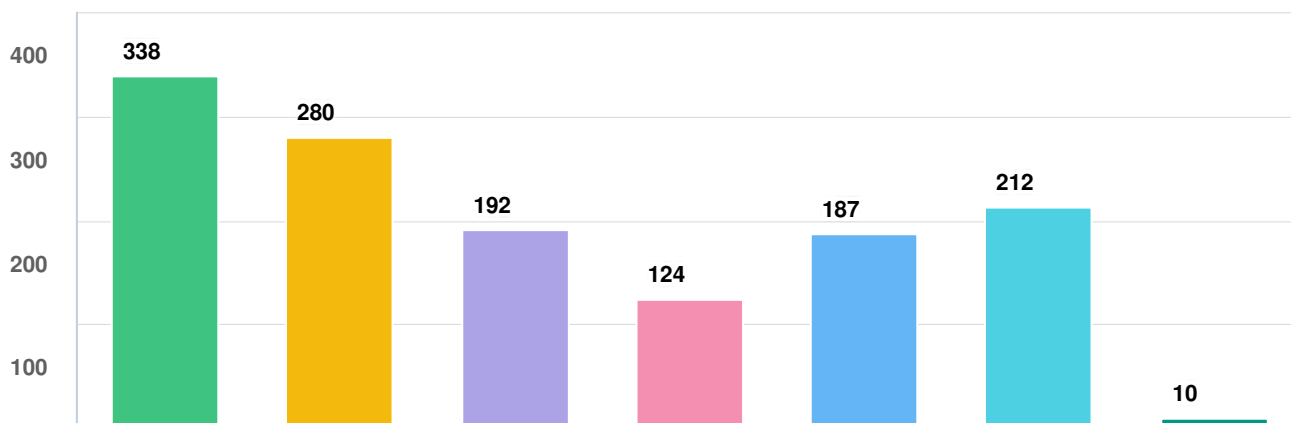

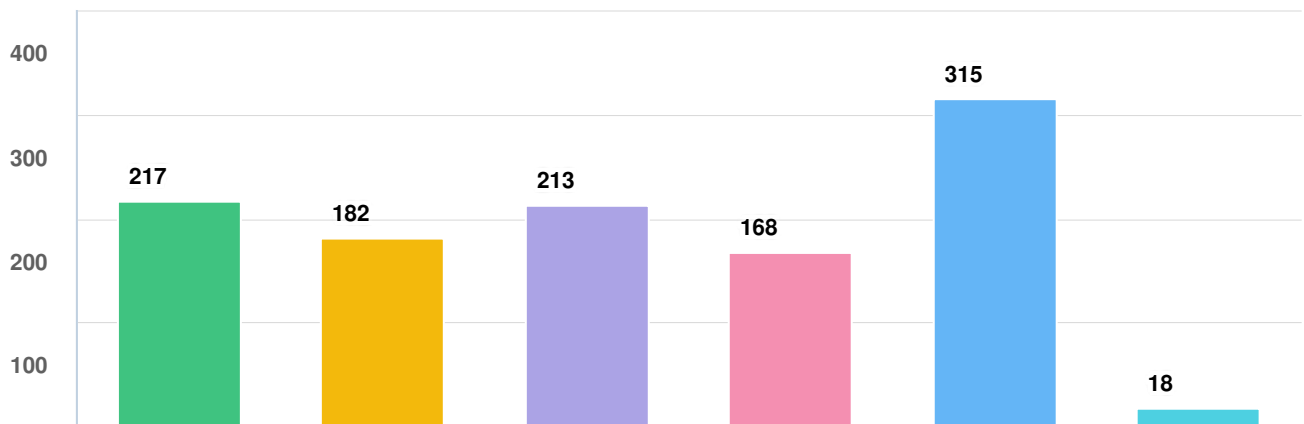

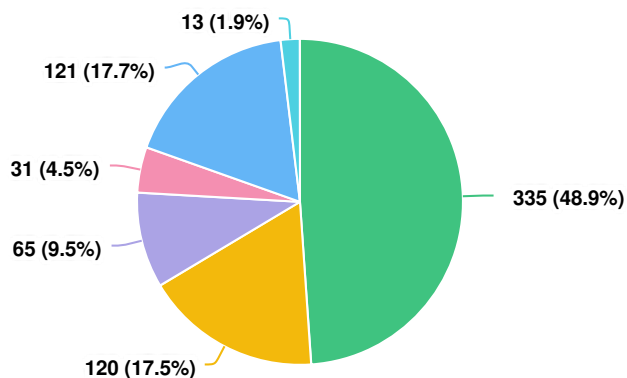

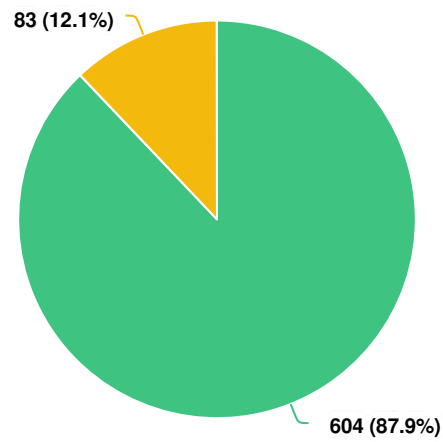

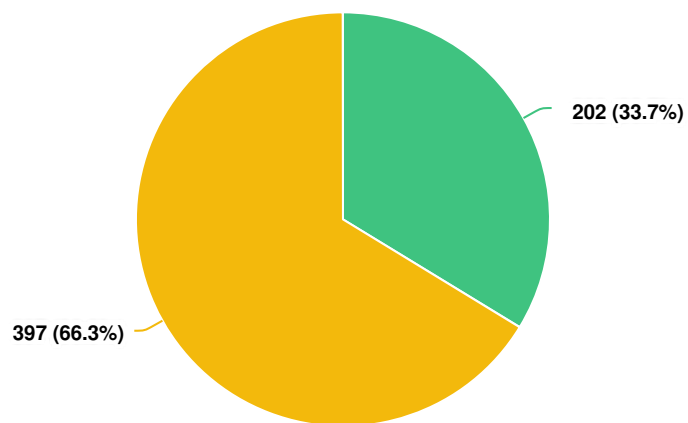

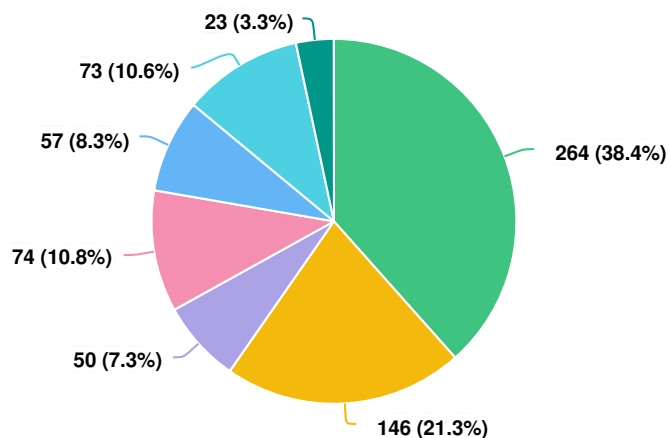

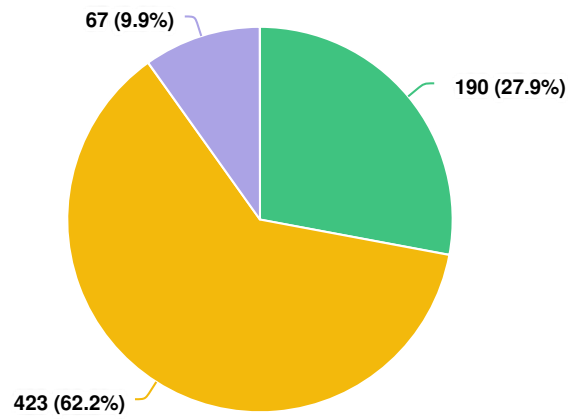

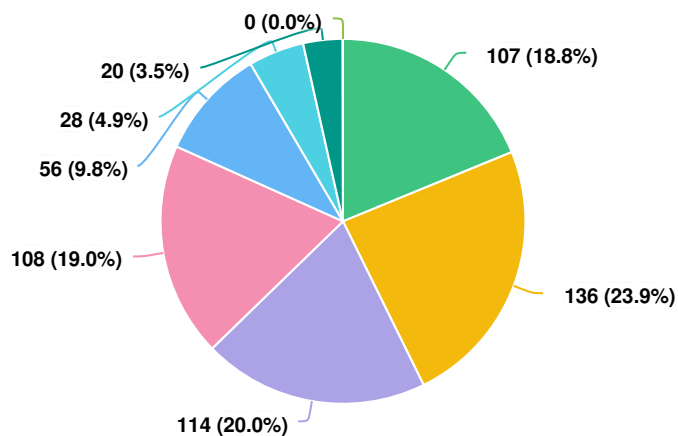

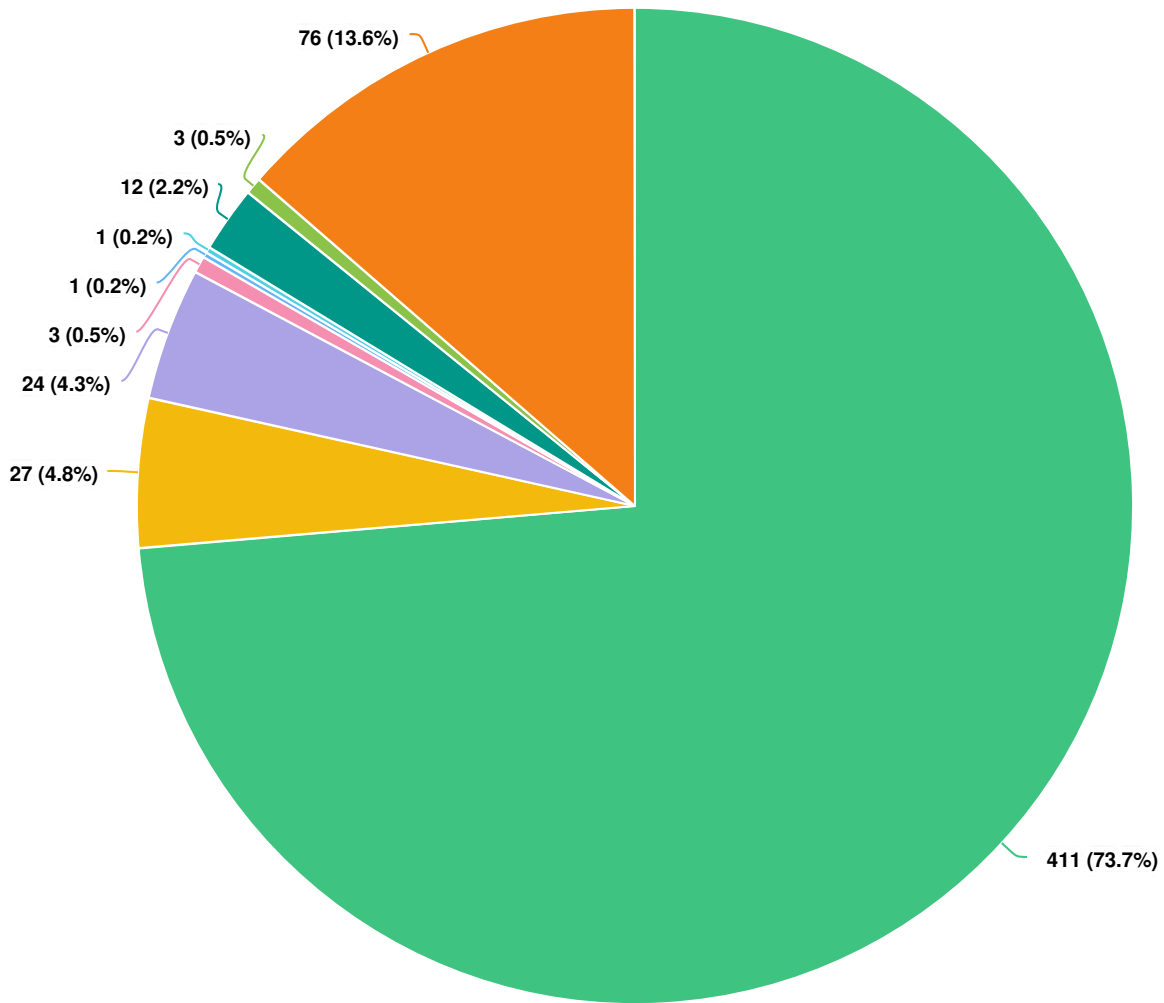

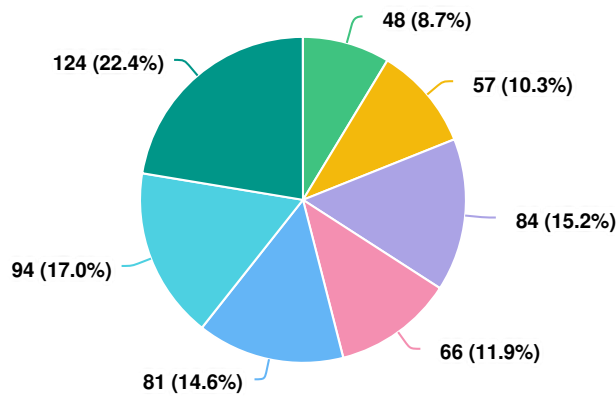

Q26 How would you describe your annual household income?

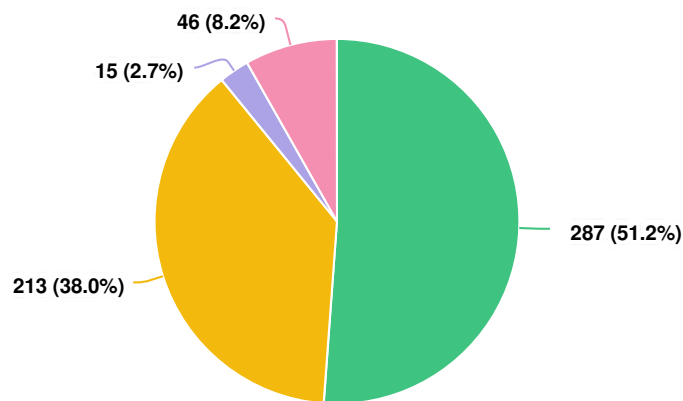
