REGULATION TO EXPAND THE GOSS-GROVE
NEIGHBORHOOD PERMIT PARKING (NPP) ZONE

Having found that the proposed expansion of the zone has met all of the requirements set forth in Section 2-2-15, of the B.R.C., 1981, and the requirements of the adopted Neighborhood Permit Parking Program Regulations, I declare that the Goss-Grove Neighborhood Permit Parking (NPP) zone is expanded to include the following block faces: 1700 block of 17th Street (east side).

The new boundaries of the zone are now: the 1500, 1600, 1700, 1800, 1900, 2000, 2100, and 2200 blocks of Grove Street (north and south); 1700 block of 17th Street (east side); the 1500 block of 21st Street (east and west); the 1500 and 1600 blocks of 16th, 17th, 19th, and 22nd Streets (east and west); the 1500, 1600 and 1700 blocks of 18th Street (east and west); the 1600 and 1700 block of 20th Streets (east and west); the 1600 block of 21st Street (east and west) aka Goss and Grove Circle West; the 1600 block of 23rd (east and west) aka Goss and Grove Circle East; the 1900, 2000, 2100, and 2200 blocks of Goss Street (north and south); and the 1600, 1700, 1800, 1900, 2000, 2100 and 2200 blocks of Arapahoe Avenue (north side).

The zone will be designated with a "color-coded" restriction on public parking as defined in the Neighborhood Permit Parking Program Regulations. Signs will be posted throughout the zone that read: 2 Hour Parking, ONE TIME ONLY PER DAY, 8:00 AM to 6:00 PM, Monday through Friday, in This Brown Zone, Except by Permit.

The city manager may issue up to four commuter permits per block face based on a 15 percent white space level. The manager may also, for this Goss-Grove zone, allocate commuter permits initially to educational institutions and organizations representing postal workers.
