


HARLOW PLATTS COMMUNITY PARK

WHAT WE HAVE HEARD

February 2014 Public Meeting

A community meeting was held on February 3, 2014 to review and discuss proposed addition of a new shelter and restroom facility within the park and a shade structure over the sand play area at the children's playground.

At the meeting, Parks and Recreation Department Staff believed that there was general acceptance of the proposed improvement plan.

Generally, comments that were received at the meeting fell within the following categories:

- GENERAL PARK PLANNING and MAINTENANCE
- MAINTENANCE and AESTHETICS
- LOCATION
- SECURITY

A full summary of the comments that were received at the meeting are available this evening.

March 2014 PRAB Meeting

After the February 3 public meeting the Parks and Recreation Department was made aware of concerns from community members regarding the proposed shelter and restroom facility.

Concerns that were raised by community members at the PRAB meeting, generally, included the following:

- Condition of existing facilities
- Proximity of the shelter / restroom facility to adjacent neighbors and Gillaspie Dr.
- The size and length and type of events that could be facilitated at the proposed shelter / restroom facility
- The size of the proposed facility
- Safety
- Continued maintenance costs

At the suggestion of the PRAB, the Parks and Recreation Department set up a meeting with a group of concerned community members.

March 2014 Group Meeting

After the PRAB meeting, Parks and Recreation staff met with a concerned community group to understand the issues with the plan that was presented on February 3 and determined the most appropriate way to address the concerns of the neighborhood and the needs of the Department.

Subsequent to this meeting, the Department developed a new alternative for a new shelter and restroom facility.

The new alternative (shown this evening) was presented to the group of concerned community members and received general approval.

April 2014 PRAB Meeting

The Parks and Recreation Department presented the new alternative plan (shown this evening) to the PRAB at the April meeting. PRAB and community members expressed general approval of the plan.
