The majority of participants thought it was a good use of their time.


Looking at demographic data, we were not representative of renters and under 40.



Percentage who Strongly agree or agree. Central results are skewed as the question wasn't asked and only a handful of people who noticed the slide voted.




South Boulder had the most people who'd never attended an event.




65% of Boulder population is under 40 and they were not represented in conversations.

Census data is for the City of Boulder, not neighborhoods.




East Boulder Neighborhood came the closest to being representative of renters.




People will consider change.
