SYNOPSIS

The City of Boulder Open Space and Mountain Parks Department (OSMP) has funding available through its [funded research program](#) for scientific inquiry into factors related to conservation of natural resources and management of recreation on OSMP lands.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

- Preference will be given to original proposals that address topics identified in as [Priority Project Topics for 2016](#). However, all proposals will be considered based on their merits.
- Awards will typically range from **\$2000-\$5000**, with maximum awards rarely exceeding **\$15,000**. Please contact Brian Anacker if your project would exceed this amount.
- Funding commitments are limited to an annual basis, but multi-year projects are encouraged.
- Proposals must follow the [format guidelines](#) exactly.
- Proposals that do not require OSMP funding may be submitted through our unfunded research program.
- Funded researchers are strongly encouraged to present at the annual research symposium to be held in February or March of 2017.
