

The City of Boulder, Open Space and Mountain Park (OSMP), staff "eat what they grow!"

With the help of the NCCC (AmeriCorps) and some Open Space and Mountain Parks IPM seasonal staff, a vegetable garden was planted on April 24, 2013, at the Annex building.



Lettuce, herbs, carrots, green beans, tomatoes, broccoli, radishes, cucumbers, onions, and peppers were planted in the galvanized metal stock tanks. These containers are a wink and a nod towards the cow-calf operations that graze 2/3 of the land that OSMP leases.



The staff has enjoyed two community salad lunches, where staff brought toppings to share, with the centerpiece showcasing the salad greens harvested from the containers. The staff will probably have one more salad harvest before it gets too hot and then resume the salad lunches in the fall.
