

Boulder's Neighborhood Block Party Trailer

Congratulations! The neighborhood block party trailer is yours for the weekend, and we are certain that it will make your event just that much better. Please remember to take and share some pictures with us so we can post them on our website.



SETUP, SAFETY & SECURITY



Wheel chocks: Verify that the blocks are securely fitted around a rear wheel and safely stabilizing the trailer. (To be placed by Boulder staff member.)

Rear jacks: Verify the jacks are safely screwed into place on both sides of the rear end of the trailer. Trailer must be on a flat, level surface. (To be placed by Boulder staff member.)



Wheel chock lock: Verify the lock is secured around one of the trailer's wheels. (To be placed by Boulder staff member.)

Zero waste containers: Recycle, compost and trash containers MUST be used at all neighborhood block party trailer events. (To be placed by party host.)



Type III barricades: If you are closing the street and have obtained a block party permit, place one barricade at each of the closed street. (To be placed by party host.)



GAMES & ACCESSORIES



Games: Look for a variety of balls, including soccer balls and footballs, frisbees, hula hoops, jump ropes and bubbles.

You also will enjoy KanJam, Spike Ball and Bocce Ball (in the red, square carrying case).

Accessories: The party trailer provides (2) picnic tables, (7) folding tables and (40) chairs for your convenience.

Also look for (2) red water coolers and (2) additional blue coolers.



REMEMBER ... safety first!

We have included a first-aid kit and fire extinguisher to keep your party safe. You also will find duct tape and extra bungee cords for any needs you may have.

Also, be sure to use the orange ratchet straps to properly secure picnic tables and other items at the end of your event.

To ensure that the block party trailer remains in good condition for all to use, it is important properly clean and return all items to their allotted spots. Be sure to secure the picnic tables and Type III barricades with the orange ratchet straps once your event is complete.

HOW TO OPERATE ORANGE RATCHET STRAP SYSTEM


Tightening instructions



LEFT: Secure hooks to ringlets.



RIGHT: Pull short end of webbing tight, removing all slack.



Start ratcheting by raising and lowering the handle.



Release instructions



To release, pull down and hold release tab on top assembly to override ratcheting function.



Open ratchet until it is completely open and flat. Grab webbing from non-fixed side and pull to release webbing.
