The City Manager of the City of Boulder proposes to adopt an emergency rule/regulation to

Prohibit any person to enter the Boulder Airport after 5:00 p.m. on September 12, 2013, until further notice, except that emergency responders shall be permitted to camp in areas designated for this purpose at the Boulder Airport. Notwithstanding the provisions of Sections 5-6-10, 8-3-21, B.R.C. 1981, such individuals shall be permitted to employ appropriate camping equipment including tents or other temporary structures.
