

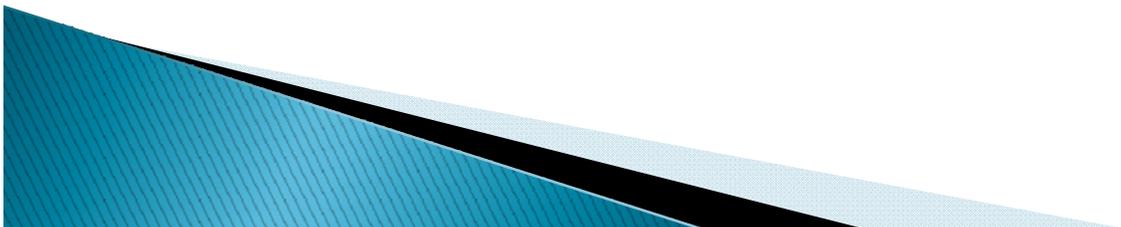

Requested Council Action

- ▶ 3 ordinances to consider:
 - 7929 – Amendments to Medical Marijuana Code
 - 7930 – New Recreational Marijuana Code
 - 7931 – Changes to Chapter 5 regarding odors
- ▶ Follow the form of Medical Marijuana regulation
- ▶ Include provisions from liquor regulation to prevent consolidation of businesses ownership
- ▶ Ordinance favor existing MMBs over new businesses
- ▶ Balance interests – industry/community



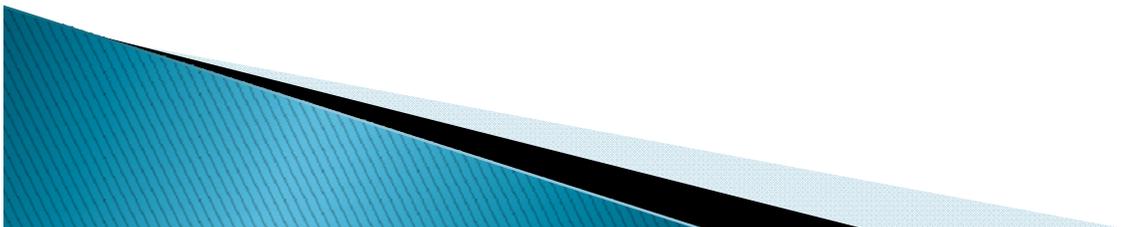
Unchartered Territory

- ▶ Do not know scope
- ▶ Do not know effect on MMBs
- ▶ Do not have assistance from state
- ▶ Message for recreational marijuana was to regulate like alcohol, but no standards
- ▶ Boulder only large jurisdiction that has successfully implemented marijuana regulations
- ▶ Recommend starting with what we know and change law as circumstances indicate



Proposed Schedule

- ▶ Stop acceptance of new MMB applications:
3/1/14 to 9/30/14
- ▶ Accept applications for conversion MMB → RMB:
6/1/14
- ▶ Accept applications for new MMB or RMB:
10/1/14




First Reading Issues

- ▶ Grandfathering:
 - Recommended change for 1,000 plant limit
 - Do not recommend change for distance to schools
 - ▶ 1,000 plant limit:
 - Sgt. Kessler will address
 - ▶ Co-location:
 - Physical separation and separate license required
 - Council could count a co-located business as one business for 500 foot separation





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
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Co-location of Recreational and Medical Marijuana Retail Outlets




Questions for Council
