

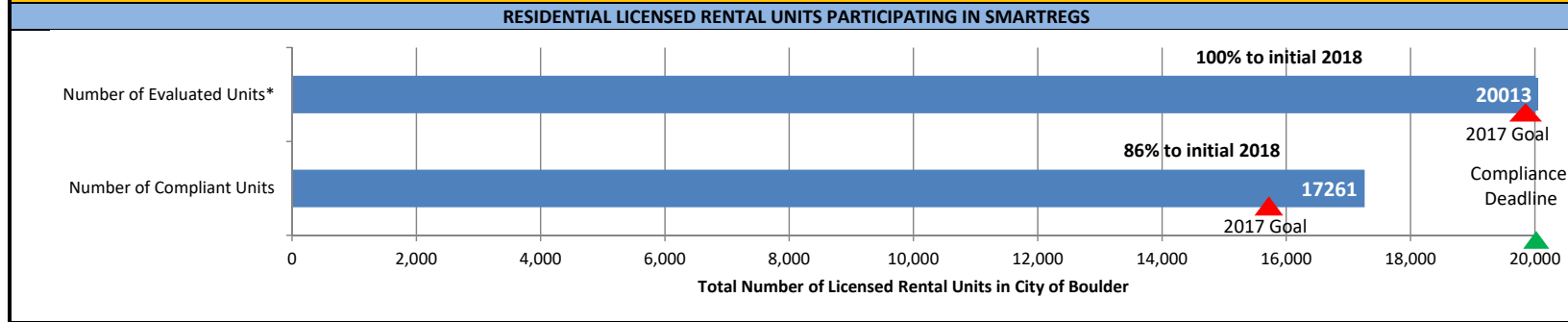


## SmartRegs Program-to-Date Progress Report

\*\*\* 4,603 upgrades and 27,951 quick installs have been completed through EnergySmart. Units may receive multiple quick installs and/or make multiple upgrades. Quick installs include light bulbs, shower heads, faucet aerators, weatherstripping, and programmable thermostats.

^ Exemptions include: ADUs and attached OAU's, mobile homes, new units/buildings permitted after July 19, 2001, and units that have received free weatherization through LPEC.
