




# SmartRegs Program-to-Date Progress Report



This page summarizes progress to date since January 2011 in achieving the City of Boulder's energy efficiency goals through the SmartRegs ordinance. This progress reported is based on data from the EnergySmart service along with data from SmartRegs inspection reports.

^ 5,195 upgrades and 28,757 quick installs have been completed through EnergySmart. Units may receive multiple quick installs and/or make multiple upgrades. Quick installs include light bulbs, shower heads, faucet aerators, weatherstripping, and programmable thermostats.

^^ Exemptions include: ADUs and attached OAU, mobile homes, new units/buildings permitted after July 19, 2001, and units that have received free weatherization through LPEC.
