

TABOR PRO/CON notice requirements

Any registered elector in the City of Boulder may submit pro or con statements regarding any taxing- or bonding-related ballot issues. There are two items that fall into that category this year Ballot Issues 2A and 2B. The information that is received will then be summarized and included in the TABOR Notice that is sent to voters prior to the election.

The deadline for submitting Pro or Con statements with the City Clerk is 5:00 p.m. on Friday, Sept. 20, 2013. There will be no extensions.

The following requirements apply:

- Statements should not mention names of persons or private groups.
- Statements may not include any endorsements of or resolutions against any ballot issue.
- Each statement **must** be signed by a City of Boulder registered voter in order to be accepted.
- Each statement is limited to a maximum of 500 words, and it is recommended that bullet points be used. Please be aware that your writing is unlikely to be reprinted in its entirety. It is the responsibility of the city clerk to summarize comments received so that each issue has no more than 500 words in the pro statement and no more than 500 words in the con statement.
