




The Transportation Master Plan (TMP) is Boulder's blueprint for an accessible and connected community through 2035

# 2014 TMP OBJECTIVES

## VISION

*"Create and maintain a safe and efficient transportation system that meets the sustainability goals of the community to accommodate increased trips by providing travel choices and reducing the share of single-occupant vehicle (SOV) trips"*



- Reduce Vehicle Miles Traveled (VMT) by 20%
- Reduce SOV to 20% of trips while increasing the % of walking, biking, and transit trips
- Reduce Mobile Source Emissions
- Max of 20% Roadways at LOS F
- Expand Fiscally Viable Alternatives for Residents & Employees
- Increase Alternatives with rate of Employee Growth
- Safety Vision Zero
- Increase Neighborhood Accessibility
- Reduce VMT per Capita by 20% for Residents & non resident Employees

## GOALS

The goals of the TMP reflect the broad community vision of the Boulder Valley Comprehensive Plan

- An integrated, multimodal transportation system emphasizing the role of the pedestrian mode as the primary mode of travel.
- A transportation system supportive of community goals
- Sufficient, timely, and equitable financing mechanisms for transportation
- Public participation and regional coordination in transportation planning
- A transportation system supportive of desired land use patterns and functional, attractive urban design
