Transit planning is part of the **Complete Streets** focus area of the Transportation Master Plan. **Complete Streets** accommodate all modes of transportation by keeping all roadway users in mind as facilities are planned, designed and constructed.

BOULDER'S TRANSIT SYSTEM IS A KEY PART OF OUR COMPLETE STREETS

In partnership with RTD, our community has worked hard to build reliable and convenient transit services. Dubbed the 'Community Transit Network,' this system was created to remove the common barriers to transit use. Coupled with the success of Eco Pass program, transit use in Boulder has increased significantly.



Since 1990, ridership on our local transit routes has grown by 300%



Folks in Boulder take transit at more than twice the national average!

WE STILL HAVE A LOT OF WORK TO DO!



Have not been able to fund new local route since 2003.



Revenue is stagnant and local transit service in Boulder is declining.



We are not on course to meet city TMP goals and new sustainability and climate commitment goals.



Eastern Boulder and surrounding communities are developing quickly and we need to plan for transition areas.



50,000 people commute into Boulder to work each day. Serving regional commuters continues to be a challenge.
