




Pollinator Appreciation Month 2016 Tour de Hive

1 **Bob Greene - Top Bar Oasis**
820 Gilpin Drive, Boulder CO 80303

The beehives are located in the backyard. Please enter through the gate on the right side of the house to see his apiary with seven Top Bar hives and a Warre hive. Bob has windows on each of his hives!

2 **Fairview High School Net Zero Hives**

Two Langstroth hives are located through the fence gate in the backyard overlooking beautiful South Boulder. "Net Zero" is the Environmental Sustainability and Beekeeping Club at Fairview High School. Several students will be there to answer questions. Pop on by!

3 **Kristina Williams - Beekeeping Consultant and Biologist**

There are three big spruce trees in the front yard and the beehives are situated in the backyard. Kristina, an entomologist, has bumblebee nests and BeesNeeds (CU's Citizen Science Program) blocks in addition to observation, Langstroth, Top Bar, and Flow-Lite hives. This is a honeybee and native pollinator paradise!
