REGULATION CREATING THE WEST PEARL
NEIGHBORHOOD PERMIT PARKING (NPP) ZONE

Having found that the proposed zone has met all of the requirements set forth in Section 2-2-15, B.R.C., 1981, and the requirements for the adopted Neighborhood Permit Parking Program Regulations, I declare that the West Pearl Neighborhood Permit Parking (NPP) zone includes the following block faces:

Pearl Street from 401 thru 741 (north) and Pearl Street 406 thru 646 (south)

1900 block of 7th Street North half from alley to Pearl Street (east and west)

2000 block of 4th Street (east and west)

2000 block of 5th Street (east and west)

Spruce Street from 327 thru 429 (north side) and the 400 block (south side)

The zone will be designated with a "color-coded" restriction on public parking as defined in the Neighborhood Permit Parking Program Regulations in effect May 30, 1997 or thereafter. Signs will be posted throughout the zone that read: 3 Hour Parking, One Time Only Per Day, 8:00 AM to 6:00 PM, Monday through Friday, in This Yellow Zone, Except by Permit.

All NPP Regulations shall apply with the following exceptions: all properties designated by the City of Boulder as condominiums or properties designated as containing higher than four (4) units shall be limited to one (1) resident permit and one (1) visitor permit per unit. These properties include but are not limited to:

2000 and 2020 5th Street; 375, 410, 412, 414, 416, 420, 426, 428, 430, 432, 438, 508, 608, 620, 625, 645, 700, 701, 702, 753, and 755 Pearl Street; and 1945 6th Street.

Up to four commuter permits per block face will be available for purchase by non-zone residents on a quarterly basis.
