REGULATION TO EXPAND THE WHITTIER NEIGHBORHOOD PERMITS PARKING ZONE

Having found that the proposed zone has met all of the requirements set forth in Section 2-2-15, of the B.R.C., 1981, and the requirements of the adopted Neighborhood Permit Parking Program Regulations, I declare that the Whittier Neighborhood Permit Parking (NPP) zone includes the following block faces:

The new boundaries of the zone are now: 2010 – 2020 19th Street (east side); the 1200 block of High Street (north 1227 through 1245, and south); the 1200 block of Mapleton (north, from the alley east of Broadway to 13th Street); the 1300 block of Mapleton (south, from 13th Street through 1316); the 2200 block of 13th Street (east, 2224 through 2244); the 2200 block of 17th Street (west, from Pine Street through 2221); the 1300 block of Pine Street (north, 1313 through 1345); the 1700, 1800, and 1900 blocks of Bluff Street (north and south); the 1400, 1500, 1600, 1700, 1800, and 1900 blocks of Mapleton Avenue (north and south); the 1500, 1600, 1700, 1800, and 1900 blocks of Pine Street (north and south); the 2100 block of 15th Street (east); the 2200 block of 15th Street (east and west); the 2100 and 2200 blocks of 16th Street (east and west); the 1600 block of Spruce Street (north and south, 1618 through 1648); the 1700, 1800, and 1900 blocks of Spruce Street (north and south); the 2000 block of 17th Street (east, 2028 through 2032); the 2100, 2200, and 2300 blocks of 17th Street (east and west); the 2000 block of 18th Street (east, from 2028 to Spruce Street, and west, from 2025 to Spruce Street); the 2100, 2200, and 2300 blocks of 18th Street (east and west); the 2000 block of 19th Street (west, from the alley north of Pearl Street to Spruce Street); the 2000 block of 19th Street (east, 2022 through 2044); the 2100, 2200, and 2300 blocks of 19th Street (east and west); the 2000 block of 20th Street (west, from the alley north of Pearl Street to Spruce Street); and the 2100, 2200, and 2300 blocks of 20th Street (west).

The zone will be designated with a “color-code” restriction on public parking as defined in the Neighborhood Permit Parking Program Regulations in effect May 30, 1997 or thereafter. Signs will be posted throughout the zone that read: 3 Hour Parking, One Time Only Per Day, 8:00 AM to 8:00 PM, Monday through Friday, In This Red Zone, Except by Permit.

The following block faces will have nighttime as well as daytime restriction on public parking:

The 1600 block of Spruce Street (north and south, 1618 through 1648); the 1700, 1800, and 1900 blocks of Spruce Street (north and south); the 2000 block of 17th Street (east, 2028 through 2032); the 2100 block of 17th Street (east and west); the 2000 block of 18th Street (east, from 2028 to Spruce Street, and west, from 2025 to Spruce Street); the 2100 block of 18th Street (east and west); the 2000 block of 19th Street (west, from the alley north of Pearl Street to Spruce Street); the 2000 block of 19th Street (east, 2022 through 2044); and the 2100 block of 19th (east and west).

Signs will be posted on those blocks with additional language as follows: No Parking, 8:00 PM to 12:00 AM, Friday – Saturday, Permits Excepted.

Up to four commuter permits per block face will be available for purchase by non-zone residents on a quarterly basis. Commuter permits will be allocated to individuals by a lottery held every two years beginning in 1997.
