Wet Mooring	\$525	\$660	Boats are stored on the water, attached to an assigned buoy from May 15, 2014 until October 15, 2014. Dry trailer storage is included October 15, 2014 - March 31, 2015. Boats must be removed from the water by October 16, 2014
Dry Mooring Paved lot	\$445	\$560	Boats are stored on trailers in assigned parking spots. Dates- April 1, 2014 through March 31, 2015. Only boats and trailers are permitted in a mooring space.
Dry Mooring Gravel lot	\$395	\$495	
Shore Mooring	\$235	\$295	Vessels are stored on the shoreline in designated spaces. Trailers may remain on site in the Eagle parking lot. If patron desires trailer to stay in the Mallard lot, at \$200 convenience fee will apply. No trailers are permitted in the shore mooring space.

- **All** watercraft; sailboats, power boats, kayaks, canoes, kite boards sailboards etc... are required to have a valid Boulder Reservoir permit .
- All 2014 permits will be valid through March 31, 2015.
- No permits will be sold after September 5, 2014 except small craft permits.
- To transfer a permit from one craft to another, a \$50 transfer fee will be charged and the old permit must be submitted to the reservoir to obtain a new permit.

Quiet Hours: All watercraft on reservoir must remain wakeless with the exception of city-sanctioned activities and lake patrol operations;
