

CHAUTAUQUA NORTH (CAMP) NPP

Four important things to know:

1. **This NPP began Summer 2018 for five (5) years and renewed yearly.** The NPP is a parking mitigation measure for the summer 2019. Data on parking utilization in the NPP and surrounding blocks was collected over the 2017 summer. That data and input from residents and Chautauqua area visitors was considered in the development of this ongoing CAMP NPP program.
2. **The NPP regulations are in effect ONLY on Saturdays and Sundays, ONLY 8 a.m. to 5 p.m., and ONLY from Saturday, May 25 to Monday, Sept. 2, 2019, and includes all holidays.** Parkers on streets in the Chautauqua North NPP zone must display a valid permit or pay to park. Parking can be paid via the ParkMobile and WayToPark smart phone apps or at pay stations installed along Baseline Road.
3. **Outside of 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. on those Saturdays and Sundays, normal (free) public parking will be available in the NPP.**
4. **A parking permit is only required to park on the street. Vehicles parked in private driveways and garages do not require a permit.**
