

Hours of Operation:

NORTH (NBRC):

Monday-Friday..... 8:45a.m. – 1:30p.m.

Tuesday/Thursday...2:30p.m. – 6:30p.m.

EAST (EBCC):

Monday/Wednesday..... 2:30p.m. – 6:30p.m.

Saturday.....8:30a.m. – 1:30p.m.

Fees:

Drop-in fee includes 90 minutes of care:

\$6.50 First Child/ \$3.50 Additional Children

Punch cards:

\$58.50-10 Punch (\$5.85/visit)

\$110.50-20 Punch (\$5.50/visit)

\$195.00-40 Punch (\$4.90/visit)

Monthly Kids' Corner pass:

\$25/month pass (1 visit per day per facility)

Must have an adult annual pass to purchase.

2+ years may stay for up to 2 hours with this pass.

*Additional 30 minutes of care may be purchased for \$2.00. Available for children 2 or over only.

Admissions:

- We accept children 6 months through 9 years. Our numbers are based on a 6-1 child/staff ratio & staff discretion.
- Childcare is available for parents who have registered for a class, paid to use the facility, or are participating in a program.
- *Arrival & Departure:* Please present your receipt for childcare upon entry to the Kids' Corner. Each child must be signed in and out daily.

Our goal is to provide a memorable experience for your child and those in the Kids' Corner with them. To help us meet this goal, please read and observe the following:

Parent Responsibilities:

Parents need to check in at the front desk to use the facility and are required to be on recreation property at all times. If you are using the Iris Studio, the tennis courts, or exercising on the grounds, you must be reachable via cell phone.

Late Pick-ups:

Please plan your workouts accordingly. The time limit of 90 or 120 minutes begins upon arrival. Chronic late pick-ups will be grounds for dismissal.

Lost and Found:

Please label all of your child's belongings. The Recreation Center assumes no responsibility for lost and/or stolen items.

Snack:

We encourage you to send your child with a healthy snack. Even if they've recently eaten, when children see other children eating, they often want to join the group. Nuts, hard candy and gum are not permitted in the Kids' Corner. Please label your snacks.

For the safety of those with nut allergies, the Kids' Corner is a **NUT FREE ZONE**. Please do not send your child with any snacks that contain nuts. If you send a snack with nuts, it will not be opened or served.

Wellness:

If your child becomes ill while in our care, parents will be contacted and asked to pick up their child immediately. The recreation center is not licensed to provide care for sick children. Parents are required to pick up the ill child within 10 minutes of being contacted.

Staff of the Kids' Corner has the authority to ask parents to remove their child if the child appears ill or his/her health is judged to be detrimental to other children and staff. Temperatures of over 100 degrees is our guideline for fevers.

Children exhibiting these symptoms are asked to stay home:

- a fever in the last 24 hours
- *an upper respiratory illness such as infectious bronchitis or influenza*
- diarrhea, bloody stools or stools containing mucus, vomiting
- *rash (unless you know FOR SURE it's not linked to an infection)*
- pink eye and/or yellow discharge from the eye
- *strep throat*
- mouth sores that cause excessive drooling
- *head lice*

Photo Release:

The North Boulder Recreation Center may take photos, videos or sound recordings of your child in our childcare programs. We often use them for crafts, projects or advertisement.

Sunscreen:

On sunny days, we love to let our kids play outside in our wonderful play area. We will supply sunscreen, but ask that you apply it to your child before heading to your workout.

Contacting Parents:

If the staff needs to contact you, they will first page over the facility intercom. If you do not arrive within 5-10 minutes, staff will attempt to locate you. We will attempt to contact you for the following reasons:

- Diaper change needed
- Upset child (crying over 10 min.)
- Injury/illness
- Repeated behavior issues

Evacuation

In the case of an evacuation, children will be taken to the following locations, where parents may sign out their children if they wish:

EBCC: dinosaur playground

NBRC: Easternmost tennis courts

Behavior:

Redirection is the first logical step to behavior management. Should a problem persist, natural consequences and removal from the activity will be used as a form of discipline. In the event that a chronic behavior problem develops, incidents will be documented and communicated to the parent. The following behaviors are unacceptable and may result in the immediate suspension of a child for the remainder of the current day and/or a further time period.

- Endangering or threatening to endanger the health and safety of others, self, staff or volunteers.
- *Stealing or damaging NBRC or personal property.*
- Continuous disruption of the program
- *Using profanity, vulgarity or obscenities*
- Acting in a lewd manner

Diapers/Potty Training:

As a drop-in service only, we are not licensed to change diapers. Please drop your child off in a clean diaper, and know that we'll come find you if your child needs changing.

If your child is potty training, we will try and help by taking them to the bathroom when needed. To ensure cleanliness of our facility, please send your child in a pull-up or plastic pants. Children must wear underwear or a diaper in our facility.
