

NOTICE TO THE PUBLIC

Emergency Rule 4-4-3.A(13)

The City Manager of the City of Boulder adopted an emergency rule/regulation on September 18, 2013 to:

Temporarily suspend contractor licensing requirements to facilitate recovery and repair resulting from the recent flooding for contractors who provide proof of licensing in other jurisdictions and proof of insurance. Such contractors are required to obtain a license from the city within 30 days.

YOUR TEXT AS YOU WOULD LIKE TO SEE IT PUBLISHED

The City of Boulder's contractor licensing requirements are hereby suspended, under specified conditions until 8 a.m. on October 16, 2013 to facilitate response to and recovery from extensive flooding in the city. Notwithstanding the provisions of Section 4-4-3, B.R.C. 1981, contractors, not licensed as contractors in the City of Boulder during the term of this rule may act as contractors in the city of Boulder for work related to flood recovery and repair provided that such contractors:

1. Provide proof of licensing in another jurisdiction for the work proposed to be performed;
2. Provide proof of insurance required by Section 4-1-8, "Insurance Required," B.R.C. 1981;
3. Obtain a license as required by Section 4-4-3, B.R.C. 1981 within thirty days of beginning work or by the end of the term of this rule, whichever is sooner.

Contractors operating under this temporary suspension are not to be considered licensed, but to be exercising a privilege granted by the city of Boulder. This privilege may be revoked by any city official at any time without notice.
