The City of Boulder right-of-way permit requirement is hereby suspended until further notice to allow placement of dumpsters and other trash receptacles in the right-of-way as necessary for individuals and entities engaged in debris removal necessitated by the recent flood, notwithstanding the provisions of Section 4-6-2, B.R.C. 1981. The placement of dumpsters or other trash receptacle should be as close to the curb as possible, should not impede traffic flow or emergency response, and should not block drainage, driveways, sidewalks or fire hydrants. Dumpsters or other trash receptacles placed pursuant to this rule shall be relocated or removed as directed by any city official.
